Dear Parent/Guardian,

School Examinations for Years 8 to 11 will be held from Monday 29<sup>th</sup> November until Wednesday 1<sup>st</sup> December, 2021 inclusive. Pupils are expected to attend only when they have examinations but they must be present for **all** their examinations. Normal classes will resume from Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> December. Year 8 will also have a Home Economics exam which will take place during class time, and they must prepare for this exam also.

Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> December will be a Staff Development Day and all pupils will remain at home on this day. In addition, Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> December has been set aside for marking and reporting and all pupils will remain at home on this day also. Pupils in Years 8 to 10 will also remain at home on Monday 13<sup>th</sup> December to facilitate the completion of reports.

Details of your child's examination timetable are shown below. During the day set aside for study/revision your child should remain at home in your care.

This year's examinations are being held at this time to allow time for marking and completion of reports. It is, however, important that pupils continue to attend school after the examinations until we break for the Christmas holidays on Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> December. Tuesday 21<sup>st</sup> December will be a half day and classes will finish at 12.00 midday.

May I on behalf of all the staff in St. Patrick's College thank you for your support as we continue to ensure your child is placed in an environment where he/she is enabled and encouraged to reach his/her full potential.

I hope you all have a very Happy Christmas and best wishes for the New Year. School will re-open for Year 8 students on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022.
